Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to you today to share the results of our recent school survey, which has provided valuable insights into your experiences and perspectives as families of Long Itchington CE Academy. You will also see a letter from Mary Briggs, our AGC chair, who acknowledges the progress that has been made since we were last inspected.

I am delighted to report that the overwhelming majority of you, 98%, feel that your child is happy and safe at our school. This is a testament to the hard work and dedication of our staff, who are committed to creating a nurturing and supportive environment for all our pupils.

Furthermore, the survey results indicate that you are highly satisfied with the quality of education your child is receiving. Between 94-96% of you agree that the school keeps you informed about your child's progress, provides a good range of subjects, and ensures your child is doing well. This feedback is particularly encouraging and affirms that we are on the right track in our efforts to deliver a well-rounded and enriching educational experience.

The survey also highlighted a massive improvement in parental views on behaviour, which was increased by just under 30% since the last inspection survey. This is an area that we continue to work on. Recent data shows that we are not experiencing as many incidences of the most negative behaviours so we are now looking at how we measure and track those lower level disruptions in order to ensure that all children are operating at the highest standards of behaviour in school, all of the time. I am encouraging staff to talk to parents and engage with you to support our work in that, which is so important.

Finally, I am delighted to see that a large majority of parents answering the survey would recommend our school to other parents – this has increased by over 30% since the last inspection, which is a strong endorsement of the work we are doing and the direction of travel for our school.

Thank you for your continued support and partnership. Your feedback is so important in shaping the future of our school, and we remain committed to working closely with you to ensure the best possible outcomes for all our pupils.
